Metabolic Monitoring for Children and Adolescents on Antipsychotics(APM)

HEDIS® Measurement Year 2023

Measure Description: Assesses the percentage of children and adolescents 1-17 year of age who had two or more antipsychotic prescriptions and had metabolic testing during the measurement year. Three rates are reported:

- 1. The percentage of children and adolescents who received at least one blood glucose test.
- 2. The percentage of children and adolescents who received at least one cholesterol test.
- 3. The percentage of children and adolescents who received both a blood glucose and a cholesterol test.

Eligible Population

- Commercial and Medicaid members 1-17 years of age as of December 31 of the measurement year who had two or more antipsychotic prescriptions.
- Members who are in hospice are excluded from the eligible population.
